Magless 2021 Karen Keating - Cap and Tassle technique

Step One: We created a base with 8 rectangular pieces. For the first layer we used 4 of these rectangular pieces to create a 2" square, leaving an opening in the center. Next layer we overlapped the base with the remaining 4 pieces (leaving the opening in the center) and full fused at a standard schedule.

Step Two: We glued a variety of stringers in the center of each base. A few had rods and scrap glass in the centers along with the stringers.

Step Three: Once the glue dried we added clear powder to the top of each base, then tack fused to 1300 for 10 mins.

The clear powder left a nice finish and the centers reacted differently.
